Glenn is a senior systems ecologist with Cortex Consultants Inc with 26 years of experience in applied research with natural resource problems. He has worked primarily on methods for assessing ecosystem-level and species-level conservation status in response to threats on landscapes. By developing and applying various decision tools and rules for integrating ecological and socio-economic values, he works to better inform policy makers about the viability of alternative options for resource management policies. His main research area focuses on developing and applying cumulative effects methods for describing and analyzing conjoint ecological and management risks to ecological systems (esp. species-at-risk) with an emphasis on the dynamics of habitat supply and populations. Currently he is a member of Environment Canada's science review team for the boreal caribou recovery strategy, and is engaged with the Skeena River Water Conservation Project in developing approaches to incorporating climate change into local and regional sustainability indicators in the lower Skeena basin.
